### **Enough for 4-day Trips**

(Pack personal gear in a duffel bag, if possible.)

Wild Rag

Riding Pants/J Jeans

Riding Gloves

Shirts – both heavy and light (think layers)

Socks and Underwear no boxers

Leather chaps preferably chinks

### **Sleeping:**

B-rated Sleeping Bag

Pillow

### **Personal Use:**

Lip Protection with SPF

Bug Repellent (Farmer's Market local formulas are recommended)

Canteen or Sturdy Water Bottle

Sun glasses / Clip-on

Toiletries

Soap – biodegradable (Castile or other)

Sun Block

Toothpaste/Toothbrush

Towel(s)/Washcloth

TP

Personal First Aid Kit (With Favorite Brands)

Insect Repellent

Medications

(Please Note: There is NO poison ivy/oak due to the high elevation)
